Restoring Christmas

Luke 2:1-14

<u>Introduction:</u> We have been preaching throughout the year on restoration. We have been emphasizing the many things that need to be restored in our lives. I believe that Christmas is one such area that we need to restore. We need to get back to the true meaning and the real reasons for our practice of Christmas.

What are the things we can do this year to restore Christmas?

FIRST: WE SHOULD LOOK BACKWARDLY.

LUKE 2:7

Allow yourself to go back in history and back in your mind as you think about the arrival of Jesus Christ. If you were alive then, what would you have done differently than those in the Christmas story?

Luke 2:7, "And she brought forth her firstborn son, and wrapped him in swaddling clothes, and laid him in a manger; because there was no room for them in the inn."

Many times we have been critical of the innkeeper because he made no room for Jesus, but have you ever considered that we are more guilty of shutting out Jesus in our homes, and in our lives?

In the Gospel of John, we discovered that, "He came unto his own and his own received him not." John 1:11

I. Look backward to His purpose.

Luke 2:11, "For unto you is born this day in the city of David a Saviour, which is Christ the Lord." His purpose was to save sinners. I Timothy 1:15

II. Look backward as to your decision personally.

Acts 16:30, "...what must I do to be saved?"

Can you remember that decision of placing your trust in Christ?

SECOND: WE SHOULD LOOK INWARDLY.


I CORINTHIANS 11:28

It just dawned on him that there were no more cannibals on these islands because of the Gospel being preached. Great peace came to him at the thought of his relationship to Christ.


Kim Kline's Old-Fashioned Soft Pumpkin Cookies



- 1 tsp baking soda 1 tsp baking powder
- 1 tsp ground cinnamon
- 1/2 tsp ground nutmeg 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 1 1/2 cups granulated sugar
- 1/2 cup butter (1 stick), softened
- 1 cup Pure Pumpkin
- 1 large egg
- 1 tsp vanilla extract
- Glaze
 - 2 cups sifted powdered sugar
- 3 tbsp milk
- 1 tbsp. melted butter
- 1 tsp vanilla extract

Preheat oven to 350° F. Grease baking sheets. Combine flour, baking soda, baking powder, cinnamon, nutmeg and salt in medium bowl. Beat sugar and butter in large mixer bowl until well blended. Beat in pumpkin, egg and vanilla extract until smooth. Gradually beat in flour mixture. Drop by rounded tablespoon onto prepared baking sheets. Bake for 15 to 18 minutes or until edges are firm. Cool on baking sheets for 2 minutes; remove to wire racks to cool completely.

For Glaze: Stir glaze ingredients in small bowl until smooth.







THIRD: WE SHOULD LOOK UPWARDLY.

COLORADO TO FLORIDA: 'DON'T SAY WE DIDN'T WARN YOU'

A Colorado-based radio host warns Floridians, to think twice before legalizing recreational marijuana, where voters will see the issue on their November ballot.

"It completely devastated the state of Colorado," says Jeff Hunt, a radio host in Denver. "First off, you're not just legalizing a drug, you're commercializing a drug - and anybody who knows the free market knows that when you unleash the power of the free market on an addictive substance like marijuana, you are now encouraging [that] power... to get as many people using that drug as they possibly can."

According to Hunt, the Rocky Mountain State has seen a dramatic increase in the amount of car accidents related to marijuana consumption; and more young people are using the drug, which Hunt says is harming their brains.

"In fact, marijuana is the number-one drug linked to youth suicide in the state of Colorado," says Hunt.

5,577 BIOLOGISTS SURVEYED. 97% SAID HUMAN LIFE BEGINS AT CONCEPTION

A new survey asked over 5,500 biologists when human life begins, and 96% of them agree that human life begins at the point of conception or fertilization.

The researcher...took survey questions to 5,577 biologists from over a thousand academic institutions in 86 countries. According to the study, the sample of biologists was predominantly nonreligious (63 percent), with more liberals (89 percent) than conservatives (11 percent), Democrats (92 percent) than Republicans (8 percent), and pro-choice supporters (85 percent) than pro-life supporters (15 percent).

Participants were asked to respond "Correct" or Incorrect" to statements describing the biological --Steven Ertelt, Life News view that "a human's life begins at fertilization."

Mama's Bible I Peter 1:23

When I was a boy, from the time I remember—I remember back when I was two and three years of age—until I went into the paratroopers in World War II when I was 18, my mother would read to me for 30 minutes every night from the Bible. Then she would hold it up and say, "This is the Word of God!" She did not say, "The manuscripts from which we got this are the Word of God." My mom didn't even know what a manuscript was. She just knew she had a Book that was the Word of God. That's all she knew. So, she said, "This is the Word of God." I would look at it, and I would have to say three times, "Mama, the Bible is the Word of God. The Bible is the Word of God."

I have Mama's Bible—the same one she read—in my office. I've had it there for years. It is the same Bible she used to hold up. I was thumbing through it the other day. On the inside, it says on the title page, "King James Bible." That's what it says. You know it worked. It's amazing how well Mama did before she found out that it wasn't the Word of God.

I've been going to Baptist churches for 51 years. Every pastor I've ever had preached from the King James Bible. He always said to the crowd, "Open your Bibles and let's hear what the Lord says." These pastors were not unfortunate enough to have sat at the feet of those with lower education—which calls itself "higher education."

It is amazing how well this nation did when we didn't know how ignorant we were. (Are you listening?) This is my fifth pastorate. I've seen miracles in my pastorates. I've preached over 41,000 times, and I've never yet preached a sermon that wasn't preached from the King James Bible.

US Army Staff Sergeant Paul Luther Bolden

He voluntarily attacked a formidable enemy strongpoint in Petit-Coo, Belgium, on 23 December 1944, when his company was pinned down by extremely heavy automatic and small-arms fire coming from a house 200 yards to the front. Mortar and tank artillery shells pounded the unit, when SSgt. Bolden and a comrade, on their own initiative, moved forward in a hail of bullets to eliminate the ever-increasing fire from the German position. Crawling ahead to close with what they knew was a powerfully armed, vastly superior force, the pair reached the house and took up assault positions, SSgt. Bolden under a window, his comrade across the street where he could deliver covering fire. In rapid succession, SSgt. Bolden hurled a fragmentation grenade and a white phosphorous grenade into the building; and then, fully realizing that he faced tremendous odds, rushed to the door, threw it open, and fired into 35 SS troopers who were trying to reorganize themselves after the havoc wrought by the grenades. Twenty Germans died under fire of his submachine gun before he was struck in the shoulder,

chest, and stomach by part of a burst which killed his comrade across the street. He withdrew from the house, waiting for the surviving Germans to come out and surrender. When none appeared in the doorway, he summoned his ebbing strength, overcame the extreme pain he suffered, and boldly walked back into the house, firing as he went. He had killed the remaining 15 enemy soldiers when his ammunition ran out. SSgt. Bolden's heroic advance against great odds, his fearless assault, and his magnificent display of courage in reentering the building where he had been severely wounded cleared the path for his company and insured the success of its mission.
